Other

Apostille

An apostille is a certificate that is attached to an official document to verify that the signature, seal or stamp appearing on the document is genuine. The competent authority that issues apostilles in Poland is the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Ministerstwo Spraw Zagranicznych, MSZ).

Vistra offers same day apostille service at the MSZ for documents that can be apostilled without prior certification.

Legalisation

Legalisation is a governmental act by means of which a consular officer certifies the genuineness of the signature or seal of the MSZ official who has issued an apostille. Legalisation process is driven by Convention of 5 October 1961 Abolishing the requirement of legalisation for foreign public documents. Although the Convention clearly lists detailed information in regards of the overall requirements, each country established its own procedure to meet Convention standards. In Poland, documents may require prior authentication before they can be legalised by the MSZ. Degree certificates or diplomas must be authenticated by the Polish National Agency For Academic Exchange (Narodowa Agencja Wymiany Akademickiej, NAWA). Public documents, documents drafted by local Notary Public must be authenticated by local Court of Justice before they can be apostilled by the MSZ in Warsaw. We can assist with obtaining such authentication at our regional offices when required.

Legalisation process can be a time consuming, frustrating and costly endeavor. Vistra Poland legalisation service have been carefully structured to facilitate a quick turnaround at foreign missions in Warsaw.
