

Article 10 - SFDR Disclosure

Declaration per (EU) 2019/2088 regulation of 27.11.2019 on sustainability-related disclosures in the financial services sector ("SFDR")

The Blue Horizon Ventures I SCSp RAIF fund ("BHV") regards itself as an Article 9 fund. All the requirements of an Article 9 fund are considered and are at the core of any investment decision. BHV and its investment advisor have validated its sustainability practices and methodologies with a world-class industry standard (the "ZNU Standard"). Certification has been obtained for its companies and its investment advisor.

Investment Screening

BHV screens its investments in three verticals:

- Plant-based meat, fish & dairy industry along the value chain
- Cultivated Food, Fermentation and Synthetic Biology
- Other sustainability verticals around the food system (AgTech, packaging, etc)

All investments have to address at least one of the three sustainability pillars:

- Significantly more environmentally friendly than their alternatives
- Promotion of a positive effect on health
- Replacement of animals from the food chain

Investment Analysis and Due Diligence

The potential impact of each company is assessed:

- An external party conducts a Sustainability Due Diligence (comprising Governance, Environmental, Economic and Social aspects) for all investments (seed investments may be excluded because of size and cost considerations).
- BHV includes relevant governance clauses in the funding agreements (assessed on a case-by-case basis).

Portfolio Management

BHV, through its AIFM and investment advisor, strives for continuous improvements in ESG aspects of its portfolio companies in different ways.

- Tracking of implementation of potential improvements mapped during the Sustainability Due Diligence;
- Network introductions in the field of sustainability;
- Sustainability KPIs tracking of portfolio companies;
- Influencing and building roadmaps together with portfolio companies to enable them for external sustainability certifications and eventually carbon neutrality.
